LB 147	Pirsch	Provide name-change court orders to update the central register of child protection cases and the central registry of sex offenders (Jud.)	Passed by the Legislature on February 5, 2010 and approved by the Governor on February 11, 2010
LB 226	Rogert	Change the age of majority to 18 years of age for certain purposes (Jud.)	Passed on Final Reading with Emergency Clause 46-0-3 on February 25, 2010 and approved by Governor on March 03, 2010
LB 247	Dubas	Require accreditation of the Division of Child and Family Services of the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS)	Indefinitely postponed on February 2, 2010
LB 253	Ashford	Adopt a new Nebraska juvenile Code and change child abuse reporting and registry, child relinquishment, and Foster Care Review Act provisions (Jud.)	Carryover bill on January 6, 2010
LB 307	Council	Change sentencing requirements with respect to certain minors (Jud.)	Recommit to Judiciary Committee
LB 423	Cornett	Change child custody provisions and the Parenting Act (Jud.)	Carryover bill on January 6, 2010
LB 519	McGill	Provide for rate increases for behavioral health care providers and create the Provider Reimbursement Commission (HHS)	Indefinitely postponed on February 2, 2010
